

## Blurry People - Trial and error!!

### ***Initial camera settings:***

- Flash OFF
- ISO 200
- Shutter priority (usually dial 'S')
- 1/10<sup>th</sup> second

### ***Trouble-shooting:***

- Flashing aperture on camera display
  - small f-no = not enough light
    - slower shutter speed (1/6<sup>th</sup>?) and/or increase ISO (400?)
    - try again earlier in evening or with less cloud
  - large f-no = too much light
    - faster shutter speed (1/20<sup>th</sup>?) and/or decrease ISO (100?)
    - try again later in evening or with more cloud
- too blurry
  - walk slower!
  - faster shutter speed (1/15<sup>th</sup>, 1/20<sup>th</sup>) – re-check aperture!
- not enough blur
  - walk faster!
  - slower shutter (1/6<sup>th</sup>, 1/4) – re-check aperture!
- Dark silhouette = too much light in sky
  - use exposure compensation +1 or +2 stops - sky may 'burn out' - check histogram!
  - re-compose against a darker background
